This stunning clear red rose has been carefully selected to commemorate the ANZAC Gallipoli Centenary for 2015. This rose has won multiple International Gold Medals including the Best Shrub on trial and Bronze medal at the National Rose Trial Gardens in Adelaide. Every rose sold benefits ADCC QLD, which helps fund ANZAC education to Australian school children & war veteran related projects. A Kordees bred rose with large elegant deep unfading red blooms on long stems on a strong growing bush to 1.2 m. Soldier pictured is PTE William Liversidge, aged 24

Pope John Paul II

The large, pure white blooms of this well shaped hybrid tea rose have a fresh citrus fragrance. Produced on a strong disease resistant bush. 10% of the sale proceeds goes to local charities.

Soul Sister

Milky chocolate buds open to warm latte coffee, well shaped blooms that age with a hint of lavender at blooms end. A compact floribunda with clean green foliage on a bush to 1 metre high.

Sugar Moon

Long stems with pure white blooms of hybrid tea form are graced with a strong perfume. This bush rose bears pure clean blooms that are great for picking and are produced all season long over mid green foliage on a bush to 1.5m.

Unconventional Lady

This new rose has perfectly formed large classic hybrid tea blooms of warm cherry pink, freely borne over a strong, vigorous and healthy plant with a light pleasing fragrance. Ideal for picking, with long stems. 1.7m tall x 1m wide.

Eye Shadow

Single blooms produced in clusters on this neat and compact plant. Warm blushed blooms in multiple shades of rose, magenta and apricot, with a darkened eye zone of magenta on a bush to 1 m.

Golden Eye

A delightfully bright double golden yellow with a bright red eye. This newer addition to the Chris Warner Rose Collection forms a vigorous growing bush, with healthy foliage. Quick to repeat bloom over a bushy plant to 1.2 metres.

Harmonize Climbing

A climbing Persica hybrid from English breeder Chris Warner that has the characteristic eye of these hybrids. Bears masses of semi-double blooms in orange and yellow, with blushes of pink and a central red eye. Flowers fade towards white as they age and are quite fragrant. Winner of multiple awards at the 2020 National Rose Trial Garden of Australia Awards, receiving a Silver Medal and Best Climber of the Trial. Height to 2.5m.

Persian Eyes

A recent addition, released in 2020. The showy 'Persian Eyes' produces clusters of single blooms in a deep pink, lighter at the centres with a dark burgundy eye. Dark green foliage that is strong and disease resistant on a neat compact plant to a height of 75cm x 1m wide. Suitable for pots.

Cayenne

An eye-catching rose with large velvety red blooms that are slightly double.

This compact shrub produces bushy growth that is very even, dense, and extremely healthy, making it ideal for mass planting or low hedges.

Slight fragrance.

Height: 100cm. Width: 70cm.

Cumberland

A gorgeous pillar climber featuring large, double, long lasting flowers that open to reveal swirls of rich crimson petals. The flowers are nicely complemented by plentiful glossy foliage. Repeats well.

A manageable climber, this rose can be grown in large containers or in the ground. Ideal for fences, pillars and pergolas. Best situated where there is good air circulation and some direct sunlight is available.

Mild fragrance.

Height: 2m. Width: 1.8m

Deano

A beautiful Australian bush rose, bred by Richard Walsh. Named in honour of Dean Stringer, a well-respected Australian rosarian.

This classic hybrid tea sports large blooms in a very soft pink and feature dark, decorative centres. Flowers are largely borne on single stems, but can occur in small clusters.

Healthy and vigorous, this is a lovely variety for garden display, cut flowers or exhibition.

Mild fragrance.

Height: 135cm. Width: 65cm.

Impala

This neat and dense bush has a strong ability to repeat flower quickly, always covered in clusters of buds and blooms.

Each smallish flower is classically-shaped, starting an intense apricot, and softening to lighter shades at the outer edge.

A disease resistant rose with glossy green leaves and a lovely feature plant when mature. Stunning when grown in a large container. Also great planted in groups, in borders, or when hedged.

Light fragrance. Height: 80-100cm.

Kindred Spirits

This compact bush rose is ever-changing, with each bloom a blend of pinks, oranges, apricots, yellows and creams. These subtle colour changes combine with varying heart shaped formations at the centre to make this a truly remarkable floribunda.

Celebrating the wives of our governors-general.

Free flowering, classically-shaped bright yellow blooms fade to a light yellow/cream on the outer petals. Becomes ruffled when open, revealing beautiful yellow stamens. Dark green foliage.

Love Affair

This variety's large, fragrant rosettes are a gorgeous swirl of pink and apricot. You might just fall in love with this wonderful rose.

Blooms are produced en masse, with an average of 15 buds per stem, and hold well on the bush.

A healthy bush with mid-green leaves on strong upright canes.

Light fragrance.

Height: 80cm.

Mango Tango

A healthy and compact bush rose that produces an abundance of apricot-orange blooms with yellow centres.

This versatile variety makes an outstanding low hedge and is also well suited to container growing. It even tolerates semi-shade well.

Named after celebrated French textile designer, Manuel Canovas.

This variety blooms profusely throughout the year, producing white, full, globular blooms with spiral centres highlighted in a light yellow.

A must have shrub rose for your garden.

Generous rebloomings make this rose an excellent choice and a welcome splash of colour to any garden or container.

This stunning new rose from the Meilland® family is a wonderful tribute to the original 'Papa Meilland'.

A hardy and healthy plant, this red rose will shine either in the garden or in a pot.

Notre Dame du Rosaire

This rose has an unusual colour for a Rosa Generosa variety and has inherited an old world shape, but has the styling of new roses.

Produces abundant clusters of beautiful double blooms in shades of orange and pink with white reverse, and a light citrus fragrance.

Blooms appear in flushes throughout the season, borne on a very healthy plant with brilliant green foliage.

Good vase life as a cut flower, and an impressive feature in any garden design.

Singapore Far East Moon

An Australian rose, bred by Richard Walsh, and named in honour of the nurses killed following the fall of Singapore in 1942. This rose commemorates the victims of the War in the Far East on the 80th anniversary - the servicemen and women, POWs and civilians.

Singapore's blooms are a soft yellow with a hint of apricot, and fade to buff with age. Mild fragrance.

Height: 85cm.

Snow Kiss

Double blooms are slightly larger than the classic miniature rose, and pure white with a hint of cream.

A compact and healthy bush, quickly covered in masses of flowers that contrast beautifully with the dark green foliage.

Very easy-care and the perfect choice for show stopping pots.

Awarded Silver Medal and Best Miniature or Mini-flora at the 2020 National Rose Trial Garden Awards in Adelaide.

Spirit of Community

A beautiful hybrid tea that holds its formal blooms upright, displaying a compact rose bush.

The many shades and hues of this rose, from white to pink, with mauve overtones, celebrate and express the community's diversity.

Introduced for the City of Wanneroo to reflect the spirit of the local community and the broader Australian ethos. Its tight formal blooms are a reflection of the tight knit community within Wanneroo.

Sweet Honey

Voted 2020 Rose of the year by the Royal Horticultural Society. Bears small, elegant, hybrid tea shaped blooms in warm creamy shades of honey-apricot. Produces huge flower clusters, generally 12-15 blooms to a stem but can reach 50!

A strong and healthy plant, covered in bushy growth of dark green glossy foliage. Good for containers, borders and beds, and can also be used for a hedge. Perfect for cutting, including button-holes.

Medium fruity fragrance.

Height: 100cm.

Dame Judi Dench

A truly beautiful rose, named after one of the UK's most beloved stars. The blooms are richly coloured in apricot-orange, fading attractively at the outer edges.

The red-tipped buds are striking in and of themselves, and open to produce large informal rosettes with ruffled petals and a button eye. Blooms are very resistant to damage from rain, and drop their petals neatly. This very healthy shrub produces strong, arching stems, forming an attractive mound of blooms over time.

Light-medium Tea fragrance. Height: 110cm. Width: 125cm

James L Austin

This gorgeous rose features unfading deep violet-pink rosette blooms, each with a button eye. Borne singly and in small clusters on strong upright stems, the large, fully double flowers feature a pleasant fruity scent.

Forms a neat and tidy shrub with a bushy, upright habit and healthy mid-green matte foliage.

Named for the son of David Austin Senior and brother of David Austin Junior.

Light-medium, fruity fragrance.

Height: 125cm. Width: 110cm.

Vanessa Bell

Produces huge displays of mid-sized semi-double cups, held in large clusters. Pink-tinged buds open to reveal pale lemon blooms, fading slowly to cream at the edges, each with an eye of pink and gold stamens.

Forms a bushy, upright shrub with healthy mid-green semi-gloss foliage.

Named to honour Vanessa Bell, who was an English artist, designer, member of the Bloomsbury Group, and sister of the writer Virginia Woolf.

Medium-strong, Tea fragrance.

Adorable

A recent introduction from the Kordes rose breeders. This award winning floribunda rose boasts fully double mauve pink blooms with an intense rich fragrance. A strong growing plant to 80cm high x 50cm wide.

This hybrid tea is one of our most popular roses in recent times. Large blooms are freely produced on an upright bush to 1.2 metres. The well-shaped blooms are the richest apricot-gold and age with a sepia pink wash. Disease resistant foliage.

A Grandiflora rose bred by Kordes in Germany, with large blooms in clusters of mid silvery pink and flushed a warm pink at the edges. A sturdy growing plant with mid green foliage to 1.5m high.

A rose of great beauty, with classically formed blooms in a vibrant deep, hot plum pink produced freely on a strong growing upright bush to 1.5m tall. Blooms are highly fragrant and last well as a cut flower.


Heaven on Earth

Intense damask fragrance on a well-shaped hybrid tea rose, a lovely orchid pink shade. Award winning! Compact growing rose with dark green foliage. **\$24.95**



Hot Cocoa

Velvet smoked chocolate blooms with pointed buds that open to double blooms which are ruffled and fragrant. As the blooms age they develop a purple suffusion. The unusually coloured blooms are produced over glossy foliage. Bush to 1 metre. **\$24.95**



It's Magic

A beautiful floribunda rose with many international awards for flowering and health. The unique blooms are varied, with a striped combination of white and red shades that yellow with age. Height to 1 metre. **\$24.95**



Jazz Festival

A bright orange and coppery pink bloom on this multi award winning rose from Meilland rose breeders in France. The hybrid tea blooms have a light, delicate perfume and are freely borne over disease resistant foliage on a strong bush to 1.2 metres high. **\$24.95**



Kordes Jubilee

Commemorating the 125th anniversary of the Kordes rose company. Double blooms 12cm wide are yellow and quartered and have a pink trim and are freely produced over dark green foliage on an upright bush to 1.2 metres. **\$24.95**



Kosmos

Exquisite double white blooms have a central warm apricot blush and are freely produced on a very strong growing shrub type rose. Blooms have a soft fragrance. A medium-sized rose bush, growing to 1.2 metres.

A free flowering shrub rose with old world style, cyclamen pink blooms carried gracefully on arching canes. Ideal for mass planting, or for a spot in the old fashioned garden.

Double blooms grow in clusters, produced near-endlessly. Flowers start soft yellow and cupped, blushing pink as they open. Powerful fragrance. Disease resistant and performs well in hot and dry conditions.

This beautiful 2021 release, like its namesake, is sleek and powerful, achieving an impressive height of 2-3m without requiring support. Perfect for use as a screen to cover walls or fences where climbers are not suitable.

Lioness produces large, full, slightly cupped blooms of a buff golden yellow with moderate fragrance. This vigorous bush is upright and covered in lush, thick foliage, which gives great heat tolerance.

Love Song

Large voluptuous lavender-mauve blooms are well shaped on this hybrid tea rose. The abundant display of blooms carry a strong fragrance and are great for picking, lasting well in the vase. Growth is strong on a bushy plant to 1.6 metre.

Dark green glossy foliage, topped with old world style double pure white blooms. Good perfume.

Miss Jane is an Australian bred rose by Richard Walsh. Produces large clusters of blooms that are a soft warm pink with old fashioned appearance and carry a strong sweet fragrance. An upright and healthy bush to 1.2 metres. **\$24.95**

Bred by Bruce Brundrett in Australia. This charming rose has cupped buds that open to clusters of warm pink blooms, revealing yellow stamens and a strong fragrance. A vigorous and disease resistant plant growing to a height of 1 metre. **\$24.95**



Moon Glow

Soft, buttery gold blooms on this international prize winning rose from the house of Meiland in France. Large full blooms are ideal for cut flowers and have a light perfume. A healthy bush with superb disease resistance, growing to 1.5m. **\$24.95**



Mother's Love

Masses of soft creamy pink blooms flowering continuously on long stems. Lush, healthy deep green foliage and intoxicating fragrance. **\$24.95**



Origami

A small growing, strong, healthy, disease resistant bush with stunning blooms that are white edged in red. The well shaped blooms have strongly folded petals, resembling the folded paper of origami. Light fragrance on this Gold Medal winning rose. **\$24.95**



Paul Bocuse

Dark green foliage and exquisite blooms that are double with lots of pointed petals. Rich apricot flowers are lightly flushed pink as they age. A light but refreshing perfume on a 80 cm high bush. **\$24.95**



Perfume Passion

Since its release overseas this rose has received numerous awards, all of which are well deserved. Blooms of this exciting new rose are well shaped, with a high centre. An interesting blend of pink shades and a rich, strong fragrance. Height: 1.2m. **\$24.95**



Princess Claire of Belgium

Another of Martin Vissers roses from Belgium. This is a great, highly fragrant floribunda rose, with old style blooms in a warm pink. Flowers all season on a strong bush to 1 metre tall. **\$24.95**



Princesse Charlene de Monaco

Award-winning rose for fragrance at the Australian National Rose Trials in 2017. The old style blooms are a soft pastel blend of apricot and shell pink, with warm and intense tones of both. Disease resistant foliage. Height: 1.2m. **\$24.95**



Pumpkin Patch



Rose Cultural Notes

Situation

Roses grow best in a sunny, well-drained position, needing at least 5 hours of sunshine a day to perform their best. They can also be grown very well when shaded for part of the day, but they will have fewer blooms. If the plant remains shaded and wet for long periods it will be more susceptible to fungal diseases. The planting location should have plenty of air movement to help prevent mildew, but some shelter from strong wind is preferred.

Soil

Roses prefer to be grown in a medium to heavy loam about 35 cm deep with a good clay subsoil. Clay soils can be improved by adding lots of organic matter such as well rotted manure. Gypsum can also be added to break up the clay before planting. Plants will grow in any type of soil but the more sandy the soil, the less water and nutrients will be retained and should be replaced regularly. Organic type fertilisers work best in a sandy soil situation.



Step 1: Soak your rose in Seasoil



Step 2: Select your planting site



Step 3: Dig your hole with mound in the middle and rose graft above the soil surface

Planting Bare Rooted Roses

After purchasing your roses you should aim to plant them as soon as possible. If you cannot plant them immediately, take care not to let the roots dry out. This is very important as if they become dry, the plants vigour and growth may be set back – or in the worst case die. Soaking in a bucket of water and a cap full of Seasoil added for a few hours before planting is also a good idea, this just helps the plant get the best start.

Dig a hole large enough to accommodate the roots of the plant comfortably and the bud union (graft) is just above the ground level. Place a mound of soil in the middle of the hole and spread the roots out over the mound. Place a light coverage of soil over the roots. At this stage, we recommend that for each rose one dessert spoon full of Osmocote (8 to 9 month slow release fertiliser) be added. A good handful of Blood 'N' Bone can also be added to the remaining soil that is to be back filled into the hole. Tread the soil reasonably firmly, leaving a basin around the rose to help retain water, then water in thoroughly. If you like you can add Seasoil or use the bucket of soaking water.

Standard roses are planted in the same way but with a stake placed in the centre of the hole for support first. Weeping roses are grown with a pole and a rose ring for extra support.

Rock dust is a natural fertiliser product that can be added to your soil while planting to help with soil improvement.

Do not add other manure that is high in nitrogen (N), such as Dynamic Lifter, as this can burn the roots.

Planting Potted Roses

Potted roses can be purchased and planted at any time throughout the year. It is important to avoid disturbing the roots when removing the plant from the pot, as this can cause a severe setback to the plant. Dig a hole, twice the size of the pot so that the bud union is 50mm above the soil surface. Add some slow release fertiliser to the soil, then place the rose in the hole and fill with soil. Water in well and finish off with a layer of mulch.



Step 1: Select your site for your potted rose to be planted

Step 2: Dig hole twice as large as the pot



Step 3: Apply fertiliser to soil

Step 4: Place rose in the hole, backfill and water in well.



Step 5: Mulch your newly planted rose.

Feeding

Roses are voracious feeders and for the best growth it is recommended that they be fed every 6-8 weeks during the growing season. Vary the types of fertilisers at each application such as Blood and Bone, Organic Rose Foods, Liquid Flower and Fruit, or a Complete Rose Food, etc. In the spring we recommend that a top dressing of a complete fertiliser be worked into the soil. A good rule is to feed plants at the start of spring, summer and autumn.

For newly planted bare rooted roses it is recommended that you don't use pelletised animal manure for at least a few months, as the fresh new roots can be burnt and set the plant back. Water all fertilisers in well so that your plant will get the benefit and be able to absorb the fertiliser.

Black Spot and Powdery Mildew

Fungal problems mainly occur during spring and autumn, or when the weather is humid. They do not generally hurt the plant, but are unsightly.

Black spot is a scattering of dark blotches on the leaves. Eventually leaves turn yellow and drop off. Powdery mildew is a creamy white mould, which attacks the flower stems or leaves and buds of flowers, appearing as white blotches on the leaves. The occurrence of both diseases is weather related. Black spot thrives in humid, warm conditions. Powdery mildew usually occurs in the spring and autumn, with mild days and cool moist nights.

For the control of these diseases, spray with Triforine or any good black spot spray. Use these preventative sprays every 7 to 14 days during spring. Lime sulphur can be sprayed during winter dormancy as indicated on the bottle. This will kill the fungal spores that lead to disease and give your rose a fresh start in spring.

Packaging and Dispatch

Rose plants are shipped during **July** and **August**. All plants are wrapped in damp paper, and the roots are sealed to maintain moisture. They are then packaged in cardboard cartons and sent via Australia Post. Roses transport extremely well. When your roses arrive, undo and place them in a bucket of water for a few hours to rehydrate the roots and reduce the stress on the plant before planting. Do not allow plants to dry out. To reduce stress on new plants, make sure to give them a thorough watering when you have planted them.
